

Wincle Parish Meeting – Amendment to the procedure for advertising and commenting on Local Planning Applications

At a virtual meeting of the Parish Officers on 10th January a review was made of the current procedure for notifying residents of new planning applications made in the Parish, following changes made by Peak District National Park Authority (PDNPA) to their notification procedure.

Previously, PDNPA Planning had notified the Wincle Parish Meeting (WPM) Clerk by letter and included copies of all documents and plans submitted in the planning applications made by parish residents. The WPM Clerk would then post details on the main notice board and update a summary spreadsheet on the Wincle website. Residents could then view the documents by appointment with the WPM Clerk and comment either directly, or through the Clerk.

The PDNPA procedure is now to email the WPM Clerk with the address of any property involved with a new planning application and the link to the PDNPA Planning portal to view the relevant documentation and timeline for comment, either directly on the website, or via email.

It was agreed that any new local planning application details received would now be posted on the Wincle Facebook page (<https://www.facebook.com/groups/409884702553944/>), along with the relevant links to the PDNPA website planning portal (<https://portal.peakdistrict.gov.uk/->) for residents to view plans and make comments directly to PDNPA Planning, or via email (customer.service@peakdistrict.gov.uk). A link will also be put in the Wincle website 'Planning Application' page to access the PDNPA planning portal from there.
